Taylor Farms Recalls Multiple Products Due to Possible Salmonella Contamination

(JUNEAU, AK) – Taylor Farms Pacific, Inc. has recalled several salad products due to potential Salmonella contamination. The products contain grape tomatoes from a single lot supplied by Six L's, who has also issued a recall. Taylor Farms Pacific products are sold under a number of different brand names.

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation has confirmed the salad products have been distributed to companies in the Pacific Northwest that supply products to Alaska. A list of the recalled products that may have been sent to Alaska is attached.

No illnesses have been reported in Alaska or elsewhere, however these products should not be eaten. Salmonella can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Healthy persons infected with Salmonella often experience fever, diarrhea (which may be bloody), nausea, vomiting and abdominal pain. In rare circumstances, infection with Salmonella can result in the organism getting into the bloodstream and producing more severe illnesses such as arterial infections (i.e., infected aneurysms), endocarditis and arthritis. People exhibiting any of these symptoms should contact their healthcare providers.
