Mr. Richards,

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) has prepared a preliminary decision for the Alaska Gasline Development Corporation's (AGDC's) Liquefaction Plant. Preliminary Construction Permit AQ1539CPT01 was originally open to public comment from September 11, 2020 to October 11, 2020. The Department previously extended the public comment period by an additional 30 days to November 10, 2020 to grant more time for review, as was requested by the National Park Service and Sara Laumann on behalf of the National Parks Conservation Association.

The Department is now extending the public comment period by an additional 30 days to December 10, 2020 to allow the public extra time to see all the materials the applicant submitted, and the material used by the Department to make a preliminary decision. This decision is now subject to public comment until November 10, 2020.
