Regarding your spreadsheets listed below. Spreadsheet 1 is the Department's PTE spreadsheet that was modified from the spreadsheet AGDC originally submitted (spreadsheet 3). This spreadsheet was used to make Table's 10, 11, and 12 in the technical analysis report. Spreadsheet's 2 and 3 were the original spreadsheet AGDC submitted with their application on May 1, 2018. The spreadsheet was submitted in two different locations and I am pretty sure our IT folks just dropped the Rev7 from one of them so they could go up on our website, they are in fact the same spreadsheet.

I wanted to follow-up with an initial question on the files ADEC's made available at the below link.

Three of the files posted appear – based on our initial glance - to be the same, or at least appear to have the same file name. These are Xcel spreadsheets with emission calculations. Are the following files indeed duplicate files, or did ADEC intend to produce/share different data? The files in question are marked on the website as:

- 1) AQ1539CPT01 EMISSION CALCULATIONS DEPARTMENT,
- 2) EMISSION CALCULATIONS FOR LNG, and
- 3) EMISSION CALCULATIONS FOR LNG REV7.

If these three files are different, it would help us understand what got changed in the files to avoid having to go through the files line-by-line to see the differences.

Also, as we haven't received a link to the FTP site with the modeling data, just wanted to confirm you're working on it at your end and we haven't missed an email. I assume you're working on it, and as long as I'm sending this email, thought I'd take the opportunity to confirm.

Subject: 2nd Extension of Public Notice for Alaska Gasline Development Corporation's Liquefaction Plant AQ1539CT01

Mr. Richards,

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) has prepared a preliminary decision for the Alaska Gasline Development Corporation's (AGDC's) Liquefaction Plant. Preliminary Construction Permit AQ1539CPT01 was originally open to public comment from September 11, 2020 to October 11, 2020. The Department previously extended the public comment period by an additional 30 days to November 10, 2020 to grant more time for review, as was requested by the National Park Service and Sara Laumann on behalf of the National Parks Conservation Association.

The Department is now extending the public comment period by an additional 30 days to December 10, 2020 to allow the public extra time to see all the materials the applicant submitted, and the material used by the Department to make a preliminary decision. This decision is now subject to public comment until November 10, 2020.
