DEVELOP AN ELECTRONIC DOCUMENT FOR DISTRIBUTION ACROSS ALL PARTNER WEBSITES. ENSURE ALL TRIBAL AND PUBLIC CONSULTATION PROCESS REQUIREMENTS ARE MET FOR EACH ACP VERSION ALONGSIDE COAST GUARD REVIEW AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

SUBMIT 2020.2 FOR OSC SIGNATURE AND USCG DISTRICT 17 REVIEW.

PROJECT SUMMARY: THE SUBCOMMITTEE IS COLLECTING INPUT FROM MEMBERS FOR SUGGESTED CHANGES AND UPDATES TO THE PLAN AS PART OF THE ANNUAL REVIEW PROCESS. THIS YEAR, THE PLAN WILL ALSO GO OUT FOR PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT. THE SUGGESTIONS AND COMMENTS WILL BE VALIDATED BY THE STATE AND FEDERAL ON SCENE COORDINATORS, SINCE THEY ARE THE OWNERS OF THE PLAN. ONCE THE OSCs HAVE APPROVED THE FINAL VERSION, THEY WILL SIGN THE PLAN.

COORDINATE A COMPREHENSIVE RISK ASSESSMENT FOR THE COASTAL ZONE TO UPDATE WORST CASE DISCHARGE, THE ALASKA SCENARIO COMPENDIUM, AND PRIORITIZE GEOGRAPHIC RESPONSE STRATEGY VALIDATION EFFORTS.

PROJECT SUMMARY: NOTIONAL APPROVAL TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE IMO FRAMEWORK FOR RISK ASSESSMENTS. ACP ADMIN SUBCOMMITTEE IS MOVING FORWARD WITH REVIEW OF THE METHODOLOGY AND WORKING WITH RPI, ADAC TO OPERATIONALIZE THIS RISK ASSESSMENT WITH SPECIFIC FIELD INPUT FOR ALASKA. THE RESULTS OF THIS RISK ASSESSMENT WILL HIGHLIGHT THOSE SCENARIOS OF HIGHEST RISK ACROSS THE STATE. THESE SCENARIOS WILL BE VALIDATED BY THE ACP AND THE ON SCENE COORDINATORS AND INCORPORATED INTO THE ASC WITH A BASIC

RESPONSE FRAMEWORK FOR EACH. FURTHERMORE, THE RESULTS OF THIS RISK ASSESSMENT WILL ALSO BE ABLE TO HIGHLIGHT REGIONS OF SIGNIFICANT RISK WHICH ALL THE UNIT TO DEPLOY FORCES TO THE HIGHEST RISK REGIONS ACROSS THE STATE.
