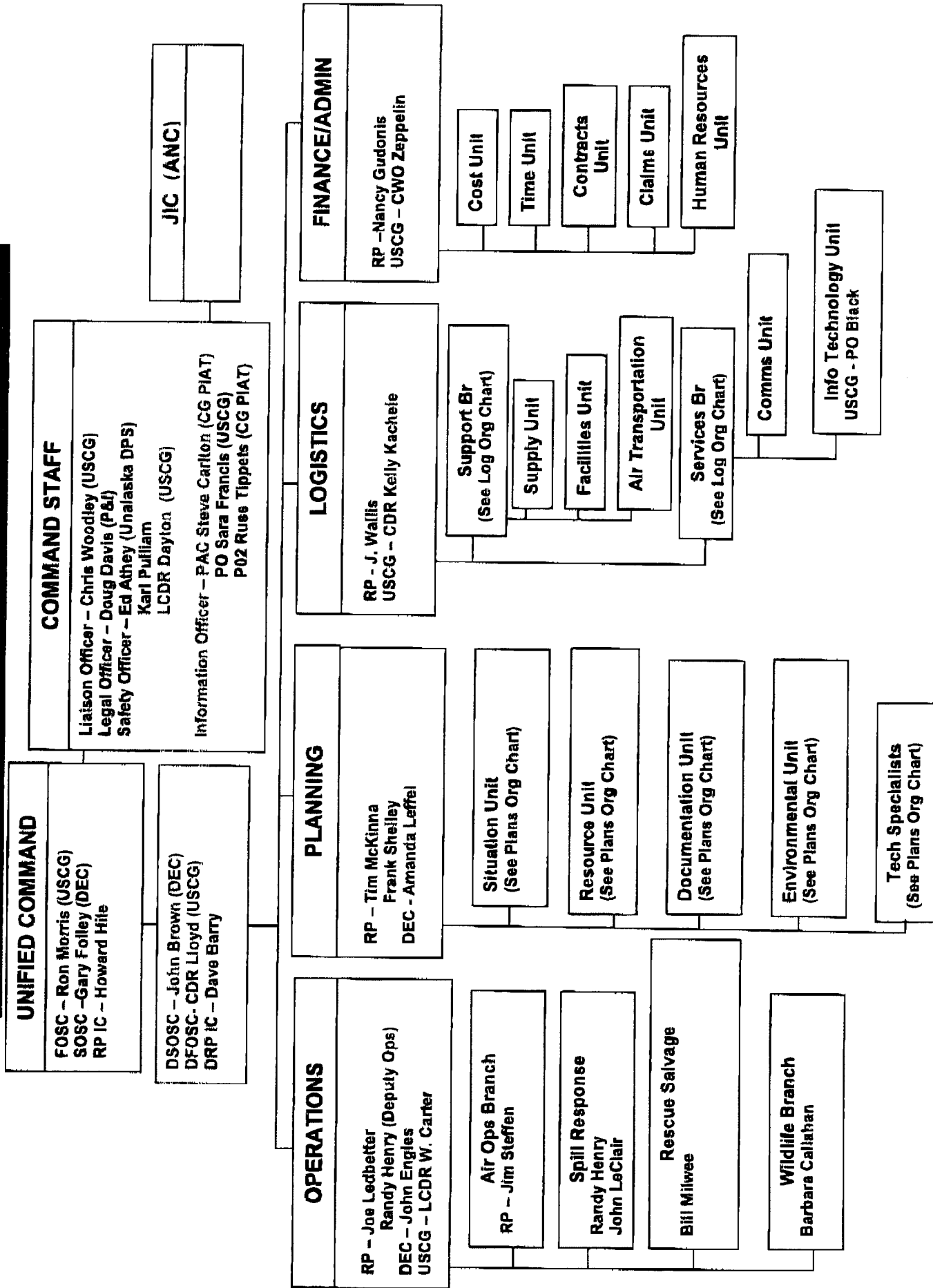

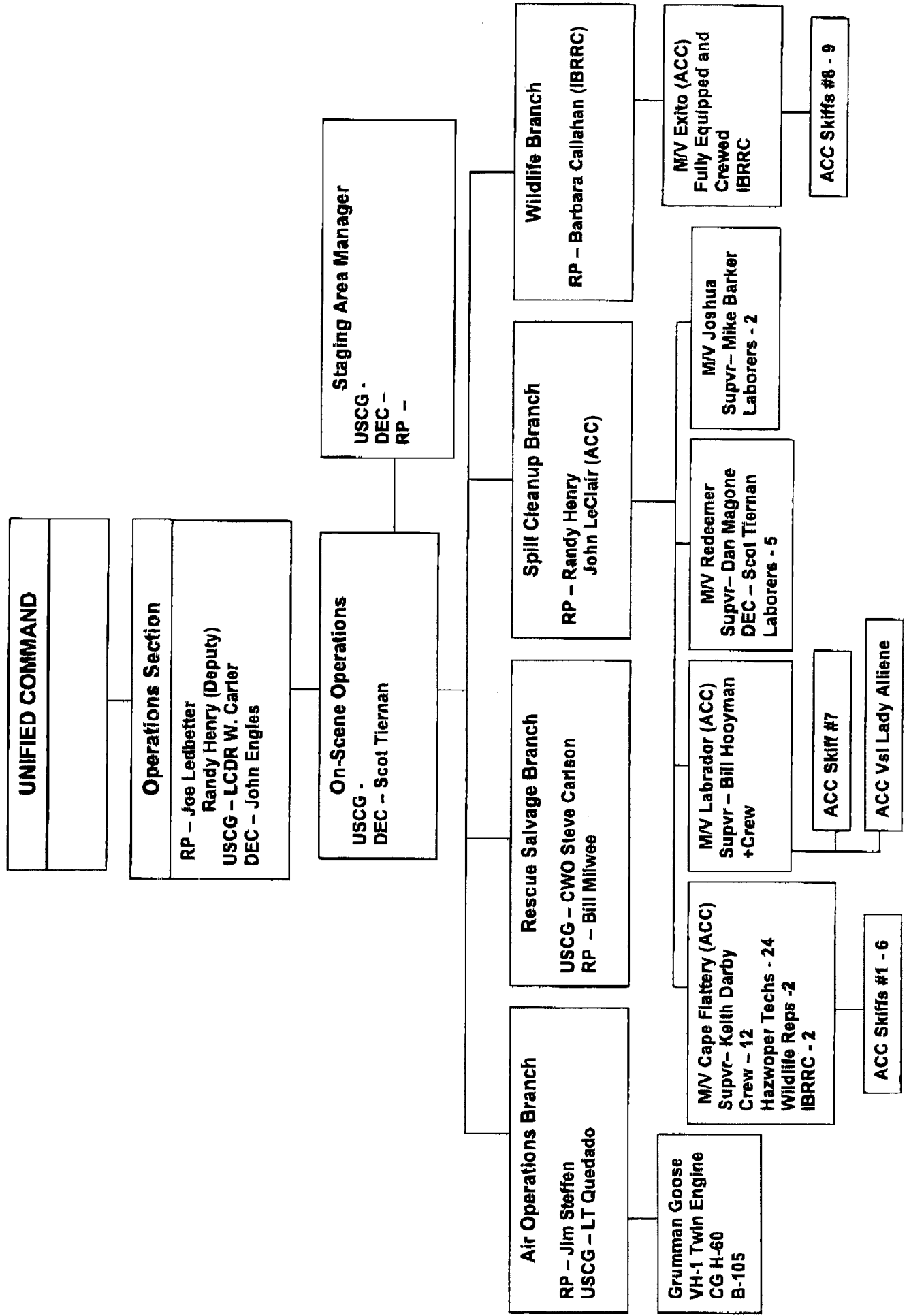

M/V Selendang Ayu Incident – Dutch Harbor Organization

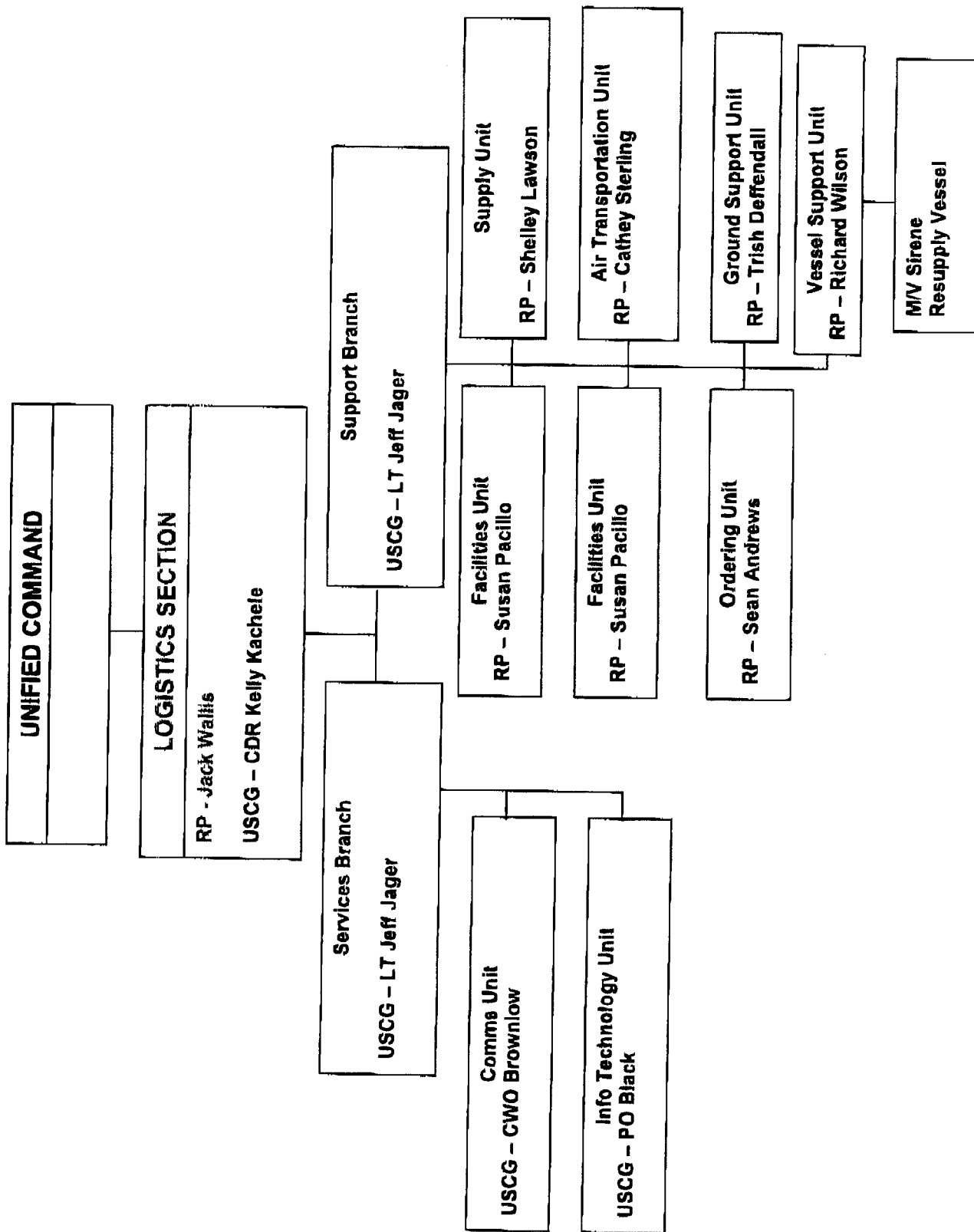

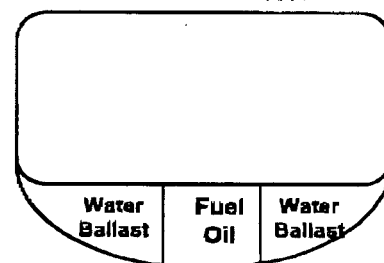
